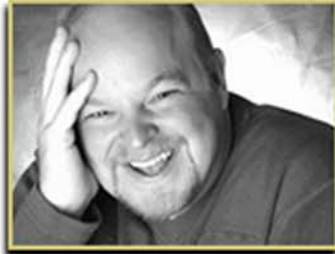


# ROB LITTLE
